| 4. Statement of Research | A <i>Statement of Research</i> describing the student's research work and results, and a description of the student's role in the project(s). The statement should be written <i>by the student</i> and should not exceed 2 pages. Please include any supporting documentation for the research project (published papers, manuscripts, design for prototypes, etc.). |
| 5. Personal Statement | A <i>Personal Statement</i> written <i>by the student</i> describing goals, aspirations, thoughts about graduate school, etc. (not to exceed 2 pages). |
